War Room Scriptures



The New Testament talks about Spiritual Warfare. It is important to understand that this has nothing to do with some sort of Christian jihad but it is a spiritual war. A war against a type of “Zeitgeist” that has positioned itself against the truth as it is revealed in Jesus Christ. This war is fought with demolishing spiritual entities through prayer and argument. Not just a war of words but a war of spiritual power and dominions being stripped of their assets.

Below are some scriptures from the OT and NT making describing this type of war and the challenges we face.

Hosea 4:5-7 New King James Version (NKJV)

⁵ Therefore you shall stumble in the day;
The prophet also shall stumble with you in the night;
And I will destroy your mother.

⁶ My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge.
Because you have rejected knowledge,
I also will reject you from being priest for Me;
Because you have forgotten the law of your God,
I also will forget your children.

⁷ “The more they increased,
The more they sinned against Me;
I will change^[a] their glory^[b] into shame.

2.Cor. 10

³ For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. ⁴ For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, ⁵ casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,

¹⁴ Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, ¹⁵ and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; ¹⁶ above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. ¹⁷ And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; ¹⁸ praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints—
